Matters Arising

- Nat Matchett has created with the help of the previous Committee a welcome pack for new
 members, recently updated with BRS information for Committee to review and comment.
 Thank you to those that have contributed, and this is now in use. Any members wanting to

- Pitch marks committee raised about ongoing issues with pitch marks and needing all members to assist and be proud of the course. To try and encourage all members to replace divots by putting in new welcome pack, introduce a social media campaign for reminders about the 'Brierley 4 R's' Respect our course, Replace divots, Rake bunkers, Repair pitch marks.

Correspondence

 Feedback from Jeremey Sheppard – email asking for soil & seed boxes on the tee box especially par 3's and if the community service could do this. Have the management got anywhere with the cashless/card system for payment. For NGU card holders courses in the area have given discount green fees i.e., played at Bulwell Hall at 12.30 midweek £6. Does our club do anything similar?

Committee and Management response – the change to a card voucher system to replace the paper vouchers has been on the back burner due to the cost of installing a new card system for vouchers with other financial priorities such as the repair to the wear tank, securing additional green staff etc. however, in preparation we have taken steps already by purchasing a new till that will accommodate a card system which is a cost at £35 each month for its software and we are just in the process of installing it now/entering all our stock into it.

You will see it on the back of the bar. The next phase would be the voucher/card system but there is not a definite date on when this will be, as we are always conscious, we will be heading into the winter months soon so this maybe an April 2024 investment.

We have had sand and seed boxes in the past and unfortunately, they have been damaged. Grant is looking at putting 4 boxes of sand and seed on par 3s but need to be movable due to cutting the tee boxes, we have also spoken to lan Clarke regarding designing some sand and seed bags which we can attach to the notice board on the first tee for golfers to take out,

We are always looking for volunteers and advertise this on social media pages and if you ever know of anyone do send them our way, we also regularly take work experience and summer work for school leavers to assist with this, we unfortunately cannot get the community service volunteers back due to a change in management and contracts with the community services,

NGU fees and members guests will be a discount of £5 off for all.

This has been discussed with staff and the discounts are on our website.

For instance, if you were to bring a guest in the week before 1pm for 18 or 10 holes it will be £15. If you bring them after 1pm it will only be £10 (due to twilight pre-discount). Weekends before 1pm will £20 and after 1pm £15.

- Feedback from Dale Marsh email enquiring about other courses having a reduced fee for a
 member's guest to play to encourage them to bring other players to play the course as a
 thought after the poor turn out at the invitation day. Committee and management response
 as above.
- HP Instant Ink Service due for renewal for the first time since bought from new at £9.99 per month for 300 sheets. Committee discussed thoughts on usage and price renewal, which has been at no cost so far due to the previous deal but now up for renewal agreed the committee do not use this amount of sheets at the club with tendence to use own personal home printers. Therefore, to look for a cheaper deal around £4.99 a month.
- From Dave Hill The Brierley Forest Golf fantasy football league will be running again this
 year and wanted to let members know. The code to join [free] on the official fpl website is :rat1si
 - Anyone can contact Dave Hill if they need help with joining the league, which provides a bit of competitive fun through the winter months. And Chomp wins it every year, so he needs a bit competition this season!

The old events room is being emptied and it is our plan to fully empty it and turn it into a changing room.

3 bays will be built to allow changing facilities, the shower and toilet upstairs will be available.

We will install a sink in the new changing room and a mirror above it.

The landlord has a room upstairs that is current full of his filed paperwork, he has agreed to remove all of this and work will start on this during the winter months.

Downstairs

Both ladies' toilets have been blocking for quite some time and the day before presentation night they blocked completely.

We had to call Dynarod in during the evening, this cost us nearly £400, unfortunately they were unable to clear the blockage.

A massive thank you from the management to John Gibson and Mathew Harvey for coming in at 5am on the morning of the presentation, they found and lifted all the drainage lids and found that one of them had a tile mostly covering the outlet pipe.

Obviously, this then blocked up with paper and raw sewage, they cleared not only this drain but also the drain that had caused the flood from outside.

So far, we have had no further issues.

BRS System

Each member needs to book online via BRS Golf, Handicap Master is now suspended.

Each member needs to sign up to BRS Golf, so far 248 members have signed up, 107 still have not.

EGU/NGU Fees.

A Total of £5,075 has been paid out this month for EGU/NGU fees.

We are currently chasing 71 outstanding payments leaving the club with a financial deficit of £1,400.

The kitchen has been operating under new lease since April this year, after a recent meeting it is not financially of benefit to operate Mon-Fri due to poor turnover. We have also installed a new electric bell system for bar staff to alert the kitchen when orders have been made for collection to further improve efficiencies.
