SB added about dress code seeing football tshirts being let out and also about tee times being taken by those that havnt booked and pay and play as go.

The Committee noted and discussed the above concerns raised regarding course care, etiquette, and general standards on the course. The Committee expressed thanks for his engagement and for taking the time to highlight these points.

The Committee confirmed that guidance on repairing pitch marks, replacing divots, raking bunkers, and shouting "Fore" is actively promoted through the club's '4 Rs campaign'. This campaign is displayed on posters in the clubhouse, shared on social media, included in the Welcome Pack, and printed on all scorecards. Additional signage relating to course etiquette and errant-shot safety has recently been added, cleaned, and repositioned around the course.

Members and visitors are reminded that shirts must be worn on the course at all times. Dress code expectations are included in the Welcome Pack and displayed within the clubhouse. Football t-shirts are specifically mentioned as attire that is not allowed and staff will pull members up on this. Management will remind staff about dress code and looking out for this the best they can in the clubhouse and with not overbooking tee times as members take priority and yes tee times will be filled for revenue if not booked but they shouldn't be over members pre booked times.

The Committee also noted that management provide free pitch repair tools, which are available to encourage good practice, and bins are emptied as frequently as staffing and conditions allow. GM is just abut to order some more.

Regarding the suggestion of course marshals, the Committee/management agreed that this would be beneficial; however, due to current financial constraints and the size of the team, this is not feasible at present. Members are therefore kindly encouraged to act as an extension of the management team—taking pride in the course and politely addressing minor issues with fellow members or visitors where appropriate. If assistance is required, members may contact the clubhouse and a member of management will attend to resolve the matter.

Tourist brown signs have been sent to Terry Cox local councillor who is looking into this for us since RB kindly found out he could get the signs made and printed significantly cheaper. Terry is looking into if this is OK for Notts/ADC in line with their policies and procedures to install, maintain the signs etc if they are printed by us to their spec. If not we are asking if we can get any funding if we have to pay the full price that was costed at £4K for 4 signs.
