• Fixture meeting was carried out 3 weeks ago with me, Nat, Grant, and Danny and this year will be almost totally digital, available on the website, through the competition platform (handicap master) and on BRS. There will however be 1 copy available in the clubhouse.

• I have made a small adjustment in February 2026 fixtures where there were 3 weeks of consecutive single stablefords on Sundays.

• There has been a significant drop in competition entries on Saturdays. I know this could be in large part to weather conditions, but the course has held up really well and the green staff have done some great work maintaining and presenting the course in really good condition. I would be interested if anyone may have any reasons or suggestions to address this issue?

• I have re-registered the club with Daily Mail Golf. Every year they run a free club foursomes competition where we enter the winners of the Dave Smith Shield. As our registration lapsed over Covid, we have entered our most recent winners at the time of registering.
